Although the deadline for submission for the Most Valuable Student (MVS) Scholarship has passed, there are still amazing opportunities for Elks families to receive financial support for education. The Legacy Awards provide scholarships for high school seniors who are the children or grandchildren of active Elks members. Applications for the Legacy Awards are online and open until February 3, 2025.
